De vita Caesarum (Latin; lit. "About the Life of the Caesars"), commonly known as The Twelve Caesars, is a set of twelve biographies of Julius Caesar and the first 11 emperors of the Roman Empire written by Gaius Suetonius Tranquillus.

Evocatus

An evocatus (plural evocati) was a soldier in the Ancient Roman army who had served out his time and obtained a discharge (honesta missio) but had voluntarily enlisted again at the invitation of the consul or other commander.
